TOEFL iBT certificates are valid for two years. Other certificates will be recognized if they were issued not more than three years prior to the date of the relevant oral exam ("parte teorica") taken in the Faculty of Humanities. In the special case of "old" certificates at C2 level, some level of recognition will be granted; individual cases will be treated on an ad hoc basis.

We only accept certificates issued by recognized examination boards that are members of ALTE (Association of Language Testers in Europe). Certificates of attendance issued by private language schools will not be accepted. Note that an "attestato di frequenza" is not an examination certificate.

Recognized examinations must test all four skills, so Trinity Tests of Spoken English are excluded.

Students must bring the original certificate to the oral exam in the Faculty and leave us a photocopy for our records.

All the scores indicated above will be adjusted downwards if the student subsequently performs badly on the theoretical part of the exam.
