Starting with a comparison of various local experiences, both institutionalized and informal, in rural areas and beyond major urban centres, we analyze innovative factors in relation to the challenges posed by population ageing and long-term depopulation. These processes, facilitated by the long-term adaptation between the community and its environment, have the potential to establish resilient territorial models crucial for the contemporary era. They address both the ongoing ecological crisis and unforeseeable events such as global pandemics. The research contributes to the investigation of centre-periphery relationships that can strengthen the role of local communities and shift the ownership of visions, solutions, and projects towards the periphery. The visiting professor is expected to possess expertise in the field of critical analysis of territorial planning, utilizing both quantitative methods, typical of territorial economic analysis, and qualitative methods, common in geographical and social research. These research methodologies have been refined in diverse territorial contexts and are recognized through the publication of results in specialized sector journals."
