<b>Project summary and VPS' profile</b>	<p>The Visiting Professor should be an expert in the field of the Italian Linguistics/Italian Media and Film Studies, with an interest in the topics of multilingualism, language variation, and language perception in the language of Italian cinema, and in particular in the interaction between language and film, language and spatial representation, languages in contact and cinematic representation.</p> <p>The Visiting Professor will offer an introduction to the study of the language of cinema and television, following a sociolinguistic and historical-cultural approach. The first part, retracing the phases of the history of Italian cinema from its origins to the present day, will focus on the close relationship between the history of language, the history of cinema and sociolinguistic interpretations of reality; the second part will be devoted to analyse the peculiar role of television in the Italian language contest, following its parallel historical and sociolinguistic (r)evolution, from paleo-television to neo-television up to the latest version of Social TV.</p> <p>A final seminar interactional activity will then facilitate students to engage with the subject through collaborative activities in real time.</p>
